- \$55 per day per child
- Some programmed days will also incur an additional fee per child. Please refer to the program for these costs.
- Late fees will apply to children collected after closing time. A fee of \$15.00 per 10-minute blocks or part thereof will be incurred by the family.

- Fees will be charged and are payable via direct debit from a bank account or credit card. You will receive a statement prior to being charged.
- If eligible, the Childcare Subsidy will be applied to your bookings based upon your personal circumstances and can only be applicable up to a maximum of 100 hours of care per fortnight.

How to Book

- Vacation Care Bookings are casual and can be made through our online portal on our website.
- The online portal will be locked 14 days prior to the commencement of each session on the holiday program.

Any last minute requests after this date need to be emailed to bookings@nwcc.com.au and are subject to availability.

Cancellation Policy

- Online bookings and requests to enrol new OSHC students at Vacation Care will close on the following date:
- 9am Tuesday 2nd April 2024
- Changes to OSHC sessions can be made with 14 days notice to the commencement of the Vacation Care OSHC session.

Please Note

NWCC has a responsibility to prioritise the care of children from our current OSHC services. However, where positions are available, children from other schools will be permitted to attend if the following are adhered to:

- Your child is enrolled, and all requested paperwork is supplied and complete.
- 2. Any medical information listed on your child's enrolment is supplied in advance and is current (including medication).

3. Our staff are respected, and the parent code of conduct is agreed to and adhered to. See our Family Handbook.
