What you need to know:

- Bookings can be made through the My Family Lounge online portal via our website nwcm.com.au/childcare/vacation-care or via the My Family Lounge App.
- Existing families can log on and follow the casual care prompts.
- New families will need to register on our website before following the casual care instructions.
- The online booking portal will be locked prior to the commencement of the holiday program on **Wednesday 22nd June by 5pm** for all services.

Bookings after this date need to be made via email to bookings@nwcc.com.au and are subject to availability.

- BASC Vouchers, if being used for payments, must be provided in PDF format, at least one full week prior to care to allow time for processing.

Fees:

\$55 per day per child.

- 10% Early Bird Discount applies if you book before **Friday 10th June 2022 by 5pm**
- Some programmed days will also incur an additional incursion/excursion fee per child, dependent upon the activity. Please refer to the daily program for these amounts.
- Fees will be charged in advance and are payable via Direct Debit from a nominated Bank Account (Fee Free) or Credit Card (plus applicable merchant fees).
- A Direct Debit form is available on our website for completion. Bookings cannot be finalised until the document is provided.
- Please note that CCS will be applied to your bookings based upon your personal

circumstances and is only applicable to a maximum of 100 hours of care per fortnight.

- Late fees will apply to late pick up. The fee is \$10.00 for the first minute, and \$2.00 per minute thereafter.

Cancellation policy:

- Requests to cancel or to make changes to Vacation Care bookings are not permitted after **Wednesday 22nd June 2022 at 5pm**.
- Bookings paid using the NSW Government BASC voucher cannot be cancelled, regardless of the date booked.

Movie Excursion:

- If you book your child into care on this day, your child **MUST** attend the excursion. There will be no alternative care provided.
- Please drop your child to the service **NO LATER THAN 8:30am** or they will miss the bus. They will be watching 'Minions 4'. It is Rated PG.
- Please complete the permission note before your child attends the excursion.

Please note:

NWCC has a responsibility to prioritise the care of children from our current OSHC services. However, where positions are available, children from other schools will be permitted to attend where:

1. Your child is enrolled, and all requested paperwork is supplied and complete.
2. Any medical information requested is supplied in advance and is current (including medication).
3. Our staff are respected, and the parent code of conduct is agreed to and adhered to (please refer to the Family Handbook).

- Please ask your children not to bring any valuables or electronics to care unless it is a designated day.
